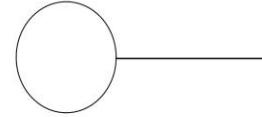




Reaching out to “All of Us” to “Do our Part”



Storm Drain Labeling: Slowly all drains and ditches around the lake have been labeled with our drain decals “Please Don’t Pollute...Drains to Conesus Lake”. Accompanying these decals were door hanger to inform all nearby residents of the best practices to support our drains and ditches: hazardous wastes, pet waste, No-P, clippings and leaves, and downspout drainage. Several hundred decals and several thousand door hangers have been distributed. Of note this year, were the efforts by John Hudak to tackle an extensive portion of East Lake Road, by himself. Dear Neighbors,

Your town, in conjunction with the Conesus Lake Association, has begun a program to label all storm drains in your area. You will see a decal, similar to the one shown below, at every drain to remind us that “all of us need to do our part” to keep Conesus Lake clean and beautiful.

Please keep in mind that anything put in our drains or ditches will quickly end up in the lake.

So please:

Don't put anything in the drain or ditch that you would not put in your own child's glass of water.

Please dispose of hazardous waste (gas, oil, weed killers, paint, etc.) properly.

If you own a pet, please pick up after it and dispose of the waste properly.

If you fertilize, please use “No-P” fertilizer and keep it off of hard surfaces.

Don't put grass clippings and leaves in the drain or ditch as they will decompose and add nutrients to the lake.

Also, please ensure your downspouts are directed to filtering soil instead of ditches or hard surfaces.
